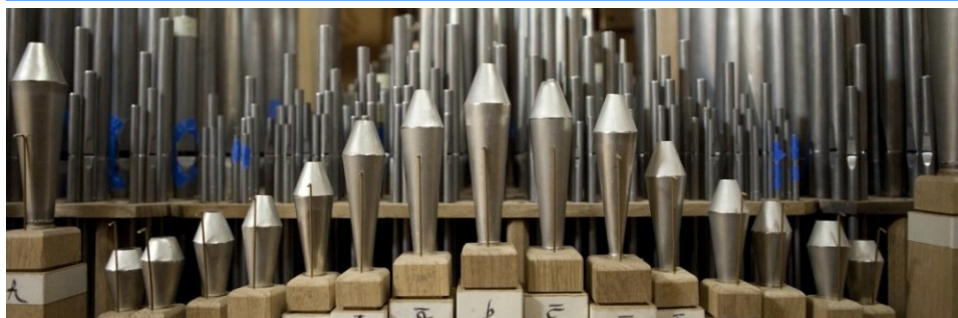

The organ studio of Dr. André Lash, at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro School of Music, will present a recital, co-sponsored by the Greater Greensboro Chapter of the AGO. The recital will be held in the Organ Hall of the School of Music, which houses the 43-rank Andover Organ, op. 111.

Recital participants include Josh Dumbleton, organist at Edenton Street UMC in Raleigh; Marya Orlowska-Fancey, a member of our Chapter, working at Wayne Leupold Editions; Jordan Hart, a piano major at UNCG; and John Alexander, organist at First Presbyterian in Greensboro.

The repertoire will range from early intermediate to doctoral level; composers will include Bach, Scheidemann, Milhaud, Widor, Escaich and others.

These students are skilled players and the Andover is a great but little heard instrument outside the University. Make plans to come and hear these promising young talents.
